- No Smoking An extensive discussion among the members. Enforcement of the No Smoking in the parks was questioned. It is not the person's responsibility to explain the ordinance to the
- offending smoker but only to make known to the smoker there is an ordinance and direct them to
- 38 the sign(s) that are in place. If anyone is uncomfortable with approaching a smoker, just email
- 39 Randy and he will pass it onto the police department.
- 40 Mingus Park Hours The closure hours of "dawn to 11p.m." were approved by council.
- Initially, it was requested that the hours be dawn to dusk.
- Council approved the recommended two pieces of fitness equipment for John Topits and approved the additional expense of \$655.
- Christine asked that the commission begin visiting the individual parks while the weather allowed. If we can't do as a group, she asked that each of them to visit a park and report back to the commission. Ariann suggested that the next meeting, August 11th be held at John Topits.

- City Docks/Boardwalk Randy mentioned that the council meeting of July 5th, the council 48
- thought the project was considerable and consensus of the council was to postpone direction until 49
- 50 report on use of existing boardwalk structures were presented. There was concern about the cost
- 51 and funding to build new docks and maintaining existing infrastructure.
- 52 - Coos Bay Gateway Improvements/Streetscapes – Phase 1, the north and south entry points.
- 53 Greenworks has been asked to do a preliminary design with construction documents. Ariann
- 54 cautioned about Bio Swells. They are high maintenance but will depend on the landscape
- 55 designer.
- 56 - Mingus Pool Projects (Three Projects: Plastering of the Pool, Tile and Mechanical System) We
- 57 had no bidders for the Mechanical System and the Plastering of the pool. At will be re-bid as a
- package this fall with work to commence sometime in the spring. Closure of the pool is 58
- 59 scheduled for August 8 into September. The tile work is to be completed by September 9th.
- 60 - Bridge Replacement – Because of competing grants, Randy decided not to go for grants until 61 after the Mingus Pool completed. Will be looking at local level, BAH and other health 62 orientated organizations for funds.
