

45 **Mingus Park Project Design Approval**

46 Staff Member Dixon reported the Mingus Park project design for the south end of the park is 95%
47 complete and is the same as previously presented, but the Commission needed to make motion to
48 approve the design so the project could move forward. Staff Member Dixon provided an over view
49 of the design and stated the playground equipment/amenities would be voted on later.

50 *Commissioner Otton moved and Commissioner Davis seconded the motion to accepted the project*
51 *design. Acting Chair Scott asked if there were any objections. There were none. Motion carried*
52 *by unanimous vote.*

53 Staff Member Dixon commented on the project schedule and stated the funding is better than he
54 thought it would be due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

55 **Story Walk in the Park Update**

56 Staff Member Dixon reported he is working with Sami Pierson at the library to try and create
57 timeline to install the kiosks in conjunction with the development of the par.

58 **Empire Boat Ramp Boarding Docks Update**

59 Staff Member Dixon reported the new boat ramp boarding docks are in, but there was a welding
60 issue with the design which required additional welding services. Staff Member Dixon reported
61 the design was by the OSMB and that he will be seeking reimbursement from them as it was a
62 design flaw.

63 Staff Member Dixon reported he will be working on an inventory for the replacement of other
64 docks and will be seeking grant(s) for the funding.

65 **Safe Routes to School Update**

66 Staff Member Dixon reported the SRTS project in Eastside is about 80% complete and should be
67 completed in time. Staff Member Dixon report substantial completion is due early November and
68 final completion mid-December.

69 **4th Street Roadway Safety Improvements Update**

70 Staff Member Dixon reported the 4th Street Roadway Safety Improvements are well under way
71 and that the curb and gutters are lower to allow for good tie-in, which will help prevent flooding
72 in areas. Staff Member Dixon Stated construction started on the South end and will move North
73 on the West, then go to the East side and go South.

74 **Commissioner Closing Comments**

75 Staff Member Dixon and Staff Member Burnette asked the Commissioners if any of them had
76 military service so the City could recognize their service.

77 Commissioner Scott asked about the status for the Topits Bridge. Staff Member Dixon indicated
78 that would need to be discussed at a later time and would require a master plan.

81 Commission, Acting Chair, Patty Scott adjourned the meeting at 4:20 p.m.
