# Acceptance of a Transportation and Growth Management Grant and Adoption of Resolution 19-06 Approving a Supplemental Budget

Finance Director Nichole Rutherford stated the City had been awarded, on behalf of the Urban Renewal Agency (URA), a \$175,956 Transportation and Growth Management (TGM) grant funding the "Front Street Blueprint" to develop needed technical information to implement much of the of the Front Street Action Plan. With this grant award, a supplemental budget was required to increase the appropriation in the Downtown Capital Projects Fund within the Materials & Services category.

Board Member Matthews moved to accept the Transportation and Growth Management grant award and adopt Resolution 19-06 increasing the appropriation in the Downtown Capital Projects Fund.
