Indigenous people have enriched our heritage and continue to add to all aspects of our society through their generous sharing of culture and their continued practice of teaching economic, environmental, and cultural sustainability; and

WHEREAS, in celebration of Indigenous Peoples' Heritage Month, the City of Coos Bay wishes to encourage everyone to join in recognizing the vibrant diversity, accomplishments and invaluable contributions the Indigenous community has made to our society. We extend our gratitude to all local organizations working in collaboration with and in support of the Indigenous community
