RESIDENTIAL BARREL BURNING MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS FOR YOUR SAFETY AND PROTECTION

LOCATION OF FIRE:

BARREL SHALL HAVE A RADIUS OF AT ALEAST 15 FEET AROUND THE BARREL THAT IS FREE OF DRY GRASS, WEEKS OR OTHER COMBUSTIBLES. BARREL SHALL NOT BE PLACED UNDER TREES OR POWER LINES. BURNING MUST BE ON YOUR OWN POPERTY UNLESS PERMISSION OF THE OWNER IS GRANTED.

SPECIFICATIONS:

BARREL SHALL BE MADE OF METAL TOPPED WITH A HEAVY MESH SCREEN WITH HOLES NOT LARGER THAN ¼ INCH. BARREL SHOULD BE IN GOOD CONTITION WITH A DRAFT ARRANGEMENT AND GRATES TO AID IN MORE EFFIENT BURN. OTHER TYPES OF INCINERATORS ARE ALLOWED AS LONG AS THEY MEET THE SPECIFICATIONS.

TIMES TO BURN:

BURNING WILL BE DONE **ONLY** DURING DAYLIGHT HOURS. **FIRES** WILL BE ATTENDED WITH A GARDEN HOSE ΑT ALL **TIMES UNTIL** COMPLETELY OUT. BURNING REGULATIONS MAY FLUCTUATE WITH BURNING SEASONS. BURNING SHOULD NOT BE DONE WHEN WINDY. NO BURNING WILL BE ALLOWED **DURING A CLOSED SEASON.**

Expaned metal screen with holes not larger than 1/4 inch 3 evenly-spaced 3-inch square vents, backed by metal screen If the screen with holes not larger than 1/4 inch Ground cleared down to mineral soil or gravel

at least 10 feet on each side of incinerator

WHAT TO BURN:

DOMESTIC WASTE **ONLY** MAY BE BURNED. PAPER, CARDBOARD, AND YARD DEBRIS ALL MUST BE DRY.

WHAT NOT TO BURN:

CLOTHING, WET GARBAGE, PLASTIC, WIRE, INSULATIONS, AUTOMOBILE PARTS, ASPHALT, PETROLEUM TREATED MATERIAL, RUBBER PRODUCTS, ANIMAL REMAINS, ANIMAL OR VEGETABLE MATTER RESULTING FROM THE HANDLING, PREPARATION, COOKING OR SERVICING OF FOOD AND ANY OTHER MATERIAL WHICH NORMALLY EMITS DENSE SMOKE OR NOXIOUS ODORS.

RESIDENTIAL OPEN BURNING

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

FOR YOUR SAFETY AND PROTECTION

RESIDENTIAL BURNS WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF COOS BAY DO NOT REQUIRE A PERMIT. ALL LAND CLEARING, HOME REMODELING OR ANY COMMERCIAL ESTABLISHMENT MUST OBTAIN A PERMIT FROM THE LOCAL DEPARMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY, PERMITS MUST THEN BE OBTAINED FROM THE FIRE DEPARTMENT BUSINESS OFFICE AT 150 S. 4^{TH} STREET.

LOCATION OF FIRE:

NOT LESS THAN 50 FEET FROM ANY STRUCTURE WITH ADEQUATE PROVISIONS MADE TO PREVENT FIRE FORM SPREADING TO WITHIN 50 FEET OF ANY STRUCTURE. THE DISTANCE THAT YOU MAY BURN MAY BE REDUCED TO 25 FEET IF THE PILE IS A MAXIMUM OF 3 FOOT IN WIDTH AND 2 FOOT IN HEIGHT. BURNING MUST BE ON YOUR OWN PROPERTY UNLESS PERMISSION OF THE OWNER IS GRANTED.

TIMES TO BURN:

BURNING WILL BE DONE ONLY DURING DAYLIGHT HOURS. FIRES WILL BE ATTENDED WITH A GARDEN HOSE AT ALL TIMES UNTIL COMPLETELY OUT. BURNING REGULATIONS MAY FLUCTURATE WITH BURNING SEASONS. BURNING SHOULD NOT BE DONE WHEN WINDY. NO BURNING WILL BE ALLOWED DURING A CLOSED SEASON.

WHAT TO BURN:

DOMESTIC WASTE <u>ONLY</u> MAY BE BURNED. PAPER, CARDBOARD, AND YARD DEBRIS ALL MUST BE DRY.

WHAT NOT TO BURN:

CLOTHING, WET GARBAGE, PLASTIC, WIRE, INSULATIONS, AUTOMOBILE PARTS, ASPHALT, PETROLEUM TREATED MATERIAL, RUVVER PRODUCTS, ANIMAL REMAINS, ANIMAL OR VEGETABLE MATTER RESULTING FROM THE HANDLING, PREPARATION, COOKING OR SERVICING OF FOOD AND ANY OTHER MATERIAL WHICH NORMALLY EMITS DENSE SMOKE OR NOXIOUS ODORS.
