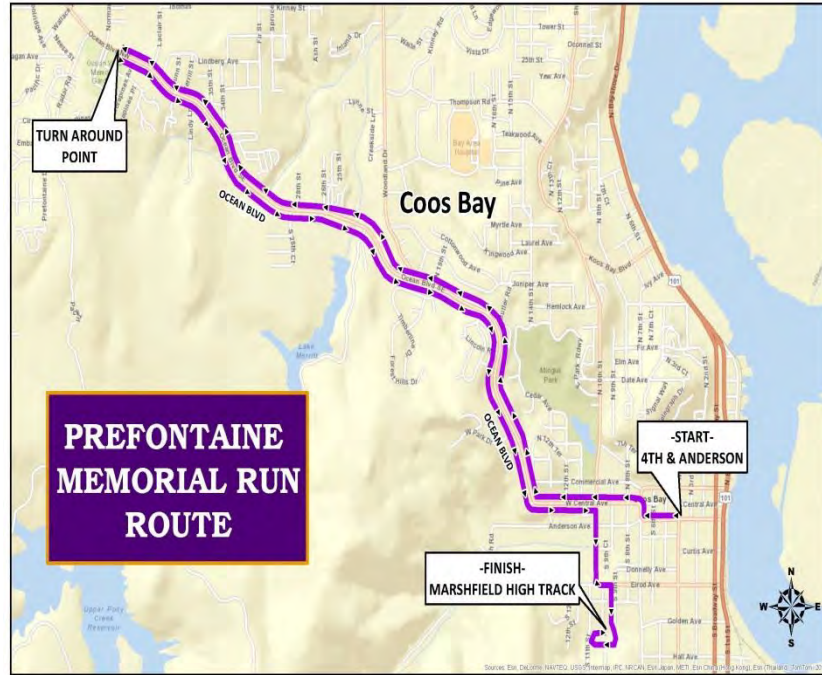

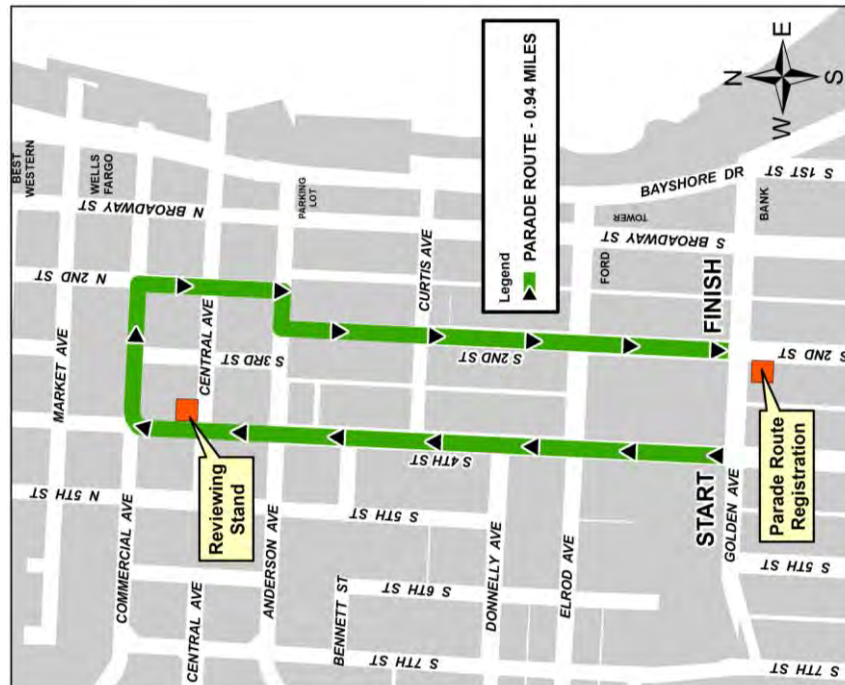
## THE PREFONTAINE MEMORIAL RUN ROUTE...
