# The Friday Update

**TRAINING, TRAINING, TRAINING** - Every week our Firefighters (career staff, volunteer, and interns) get together for various training as a department in an effort to hone their skills and thereby better serve our community.

Two weeks ago our firefighters trained with Reach Air Ambulance where they learned the nuances of utilizing this resource at accident scenes. This week Charleston Fire Department hosted training for Coos Bay, North Bend and Green Acres Fire Departments on vehicle extrication and patient movement when the vehicle is no longer on the roadway and down an embankment.



**STOP THE PRESSES!** – Staff sent out a press release earlier this week announcing a detour on Hwy 101, just north of downtown, from June 29<sup>th</sup> through Wednesday July 1<sup>st</sup> from 7:00 am to 6:00 pm while a sewer line is being repaired / replaced. The project is still moving forward but the project will be done at night (6:00 pm to 7:00 am), in an effort to relieve potential traffic congestion and lessen the effects on local business.

While the work is being done southbound traffic will be detoured into the west lane of the northbound Highway 101 from Coos Bay Boulevard to Alder Avenue. Birch Ave, Alder Ave, Cedar Ave, Date Ave, Ivy Ave and Hemlock Ave will have restricted access at the highway. Please exercise caution within these detour areas and expect delays. 
